Instructions for Alphabet Matching Cards

This PDF is laid out as a grid. The grid lines should be used as a guide when cutting.

This PDF contains a set of Capital letters and a set of Lower case letters. Several sets can be printed as needed.

You can print the pages on white paper/card or choose to separate the two sets by printing each a different colour.

Make sure each card is exactly the same size and laminate them.

This material can be used in several ways

- 1 Print off two copies of the alphabet in lower case. Child matches lower case letter to lower case letter.
- 2. Join one set of lower case letters into a frieze & encourage child to match the second set of lower case letters to the frieze.
- 3. Turn frieze over so it is hidden from view and ask child to lay out lower case cards in sequence. Child uses frieze as control of error.
- 4. Print off one set of Capital Letters. Bring a set of capital letters and a set of lower case letters to a work area. Ask child to spread out the Capital letters on the mat & keep the deck of lower case letters. Introduce the exercise to the child. Choose a lower case card and place it on the correct Capital Letter. Invite the child to choose a lower case card and match it to its capital equivalent. Repeat turn for turn until all cards are matched.
- 5. Repeat 1-3 using Capital Letters.
- 6. Using Capital Frieze as a control match a set of lower case letters to
- 7. Always encourage child to write capital letters in sand, semolina, and on paper.
