This PDF contains simple question and answer card for the Parts of the Tree.

The page is laid out in a grid style and the page should be cut along these lines to separate the questions from the answers.

Each page should be trimmed so that when mounted on Green card a Green border is visible.

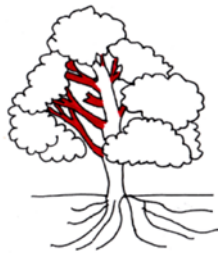
Each card should be the same size as the cards used for the pictures of Parts of the Tree.

The child uses this material after he/she has been introduced to the definition cards. The child is encouraged to find the answer to the question by referring to the definition cards. Constructing full sentences rather than one word answers is preferable.

1. Finish the following sentence:  
A tree is composed of a trunk, roots, branches and .....?
2. What is the trunk covered in?
3. What part of the tree is underground?
4. Name the part of the tree pictured below



## Answer Card

1. A tree is composed of a trunk, roots, branches and leaves.
2. The trunk is covered in bark.
3. The roots are the part of the tree which is underground.
4. The branches are the part of the tree shown in the picture

## Work Card

1. What does the leaf make for the tree?
2. What are the branches covered in?
3. What is the main stem of the tree called?
4. Name the part of the tree pictured below

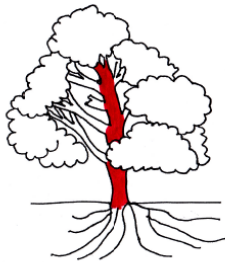


## Answer Card

1. The leaf makes food for the tree.
2. The branches are covered in bark.
3. The main stem of the tree is called the trunk.
4. The leaves are the part of the tree shown in the picture.

## Work Card

1. What part of the tree is usually thick and upright?
2. The leaf makes food for the tree but what else does it do?
3. What is absorbed by the roots?
4. Name the part of the tree pictured below



## Answer Card

1. The trunk is the part of the tree which is usually thick and upright.
2. The leaf gets rid of excess water.
3. Mineral salts and water are absorbed by the roots.
4. The trunk is the part of the tree shown in the picture.

## Work Card

1. Are the branches thicker or thinner than the trunk?
2. What part of the tree anchors it to the ground?
3. What are the tallest trees in the world called?
4. Name the part of the tree pictured below



## Answer Card

1. The branches are thinner than the trunk.
2. The roots are the part of the tree which anchors it to the ground.
3. The tallest trees in the world are called Redwoods or Sequoia Sempervirens.
4. The roots are the part of the tree shown in the picture.
